We have reached the half year mark!

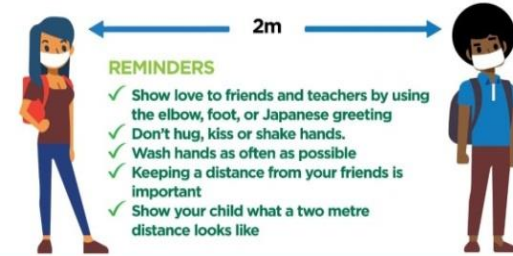
It has been a very busy and sometimes uncertain few months, but all wrapped up in exciting new ventures that awaits Bonnie People Project.

Hard at work. After stealing our power cables for the second time, we decided to go with the underground option.

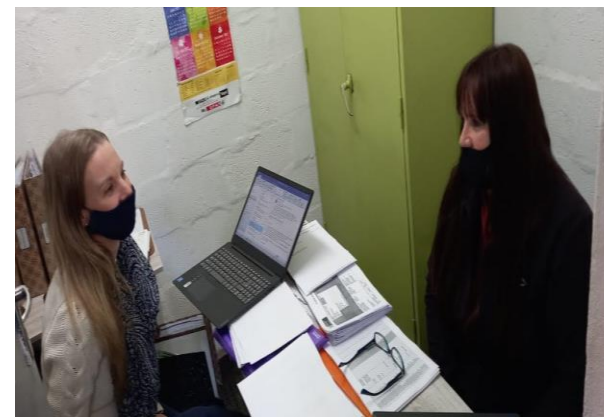

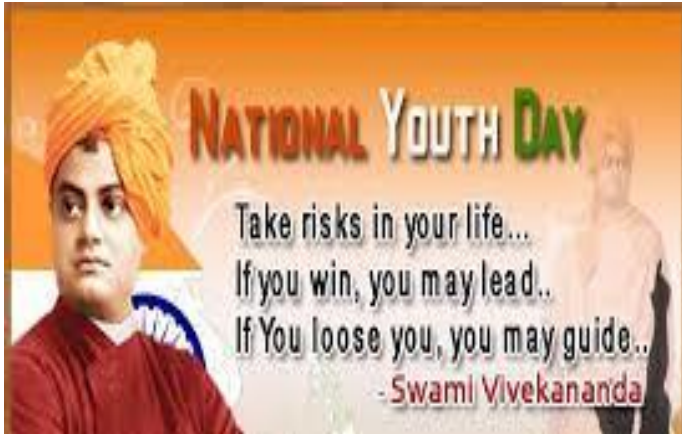
